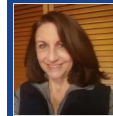

track and field in the U.S: in Oregon, in Eugene, in Hayward Field at the University of Oregon.

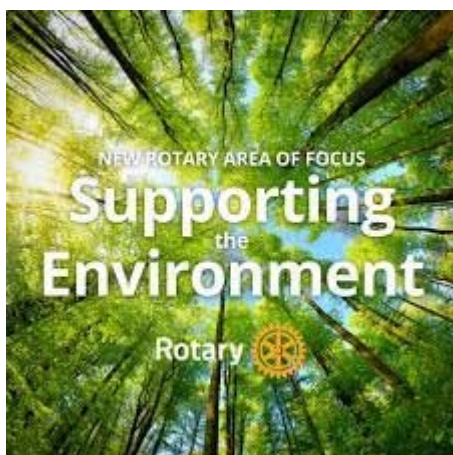
