## ShelterBox

Shelter is a basic human need. It is a determinant for survival in most disasters: essential for personal safety, security, and protection from extreme weather. It promotes resistance to ill health and disease. More than just walls and a roof, shelter is vital for the maintenance of human dignity and the sustenance of family and community life. Shelter reduces vulnerability, builds community resilience, and allows families to recover.

In 2018 we helped over **210,000 people**.

- . **30,000 families** were supported with **emergency shelter** aid and other life-saving household items.
- . **12,000 families** were supported with **essential household items** including blankets, mosquito nets, solar lights, cooking sets, water carriers, and water filters.

We worked in **17 countries**, including the United States, and responded to **10 natural disasters** and **8 conflict situations**.

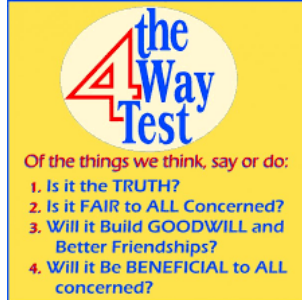
