## Rotary Foundation

Rotary was started in 1905 by Paul Harris in order for professionals with diverse backgrounds to exchange ideas, form meaningful lifelong friendships, and give back to their communities. Rotary's name came from the group's early practice of rotating meetings among the offices of its members.

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) started in 1917 with a donation of \$26.50. In 2018, the Foundation presented 1,306 grants totalling \$68,677,399.

TRF has earned a 4 Star rating with Charity Navigators, which gave it 100 out of 100 points. 91% of the money raised is used for programs and grants. After 3 years, the foundation returns 50% of the donations to the local districts to be used for their projects.

Rotary International has a goal of every member participating every year. Our club goal is to have

every member donate at least \$5.00 by the November 30, 2019.

Judy Hill, Rotary Foundation Chair, will be telling more about the amazing projects that Rotary sponsors around the world during Rotary Foundation Month in November.

  - Select "Contact" tab (or any tab that needs to be reviewed/edited)
  - Click on the pencil icon next to the information that needs to be edited (i.e., emails, mailing address, etc.)
  - Edit the information and click "Save"
