Butch at the Blue Football Field



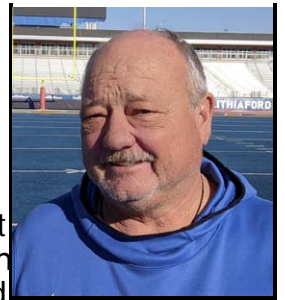
