No Thursday Club Meeting



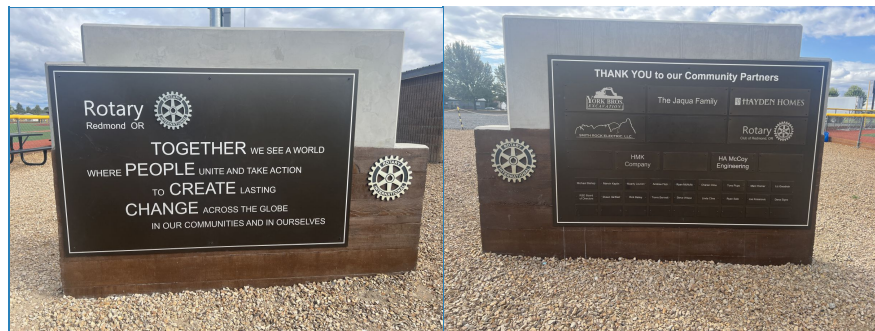

Raffle and the Rotary Foundation

Spike sent a Rotary check to The Rotary Foundation for \$902. This is the result of the drawing that was won last week by Kirstin Heydel. The drawing totaled \$3,608 and netted \$1,804 for Kirtsin, \$902 for The Rotary Foundation and \$902 for The Redmond Rotary Charitable Corp. The \$902 that went to The Rotary Foundation was sent in the names of 20 Rotarians who didn't pick the winning marble which ranged from a high of \$100.20 for Diana Barker and Becky Lu Hummer to \$33.40 for most others. Each of the 20 "non winners" will be getting an email receipt from The Rotary Foundation for their respective contribution as the result of the drawing.
