These grants annually fund \$20,000 to local community organizations that provide benefits in the Springfield area. STRIVE meetings at Springfield High will start up again on October 12th during the students' lunch time and will continue every other week until school ends in June. Last year there were 5 mentors and we would like to get 2 or 3 more soon, so a 1:1 mentor/student match could be in place by Oct.
