Not pictured but mentioned were Patricia Lawrence, who is our President Elect, and Katie Anderson, who is the Foundation Chair. In Katie's absence, Brendan Freeman, former Foundation Chair, described what foundation-giving supported, and the annual expectation that each member contribute annually \$100 to their "Paul Harris, and \$25 to Polio Plus.

The meeting was then opened for questions/comments (to the seated group) from members of the Club. Todd Walker observed that the seated group looked like a strange version of "The Dating

Game" contestants.

- Mike Murray asked about the "return of money" that the Club gives annually to Rotary International (RI), which led to a technical discussion of the size of grants receivable, and the contribution split between RI, the District and the Club.
- Lenore Hirsch asked about the current amount of funds in the Clubb's Endowment, to which Kathy Cruz responded "about \$360,000." It was noted that the reason that the Club decided to create it's own Endowment was to be able to fund projects (faster and with less red-tape) than going through RI.
- Mike Ledwich asked how well the Golf Fundraiser did (fiscally) , to which the answer was about a net-positive \$3,500
- Chris Craiker asked if the Club would be doing something similar as a Fund Raiser to the "Evening at Monticello, as has been done in the past. Justin Gomez stated that they were looking at other potential venues, and Paul took the opportunity to remind everyone that Justin's committee could use additional volunteers.

As the questions died down, and with meeting time still left, Doug Roberts took the opportunity to give "The Observances of the Day", mentioning that July 14th was:

- The birthday of William Hanna, of Hanna and Barbera Cartoons (Tom & Jerry, The Flintstones)
- Bastille Day and Grand Marnier Day
- Air Conditioning Appreciation Week
