### **PROGRAM**

Fort Bragg Garden Club (FBGC) was founded in 1955. Over the years garden club members have participated in many civil beautification projects along the Mendocino Coast. Last year Fort Bragg Rotary Club donated \$500 to fund the purchase of native plants to be planted in the newly constructed butterfly gardens in two areas at Redwood Elementary School. On May Day 2023, second grade children painted floral murals on six steel, oval water tanks which were placed in the Second Grade Wing, under the direction of artist Janet Self of Flockworks and several members of FBGC.





The second butterfly garden is in the First Grade Wing where there are six cement patios edged with cement curbed planters. These planters were weeded and refilled with enriched soil. Several dead shrubs and trees were removed. Native plants were planted in most of the area, but one section was dedicated to succulents so that children could compare and contrast the attributes of different types of plants.
