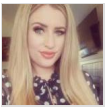

GUEST SPEAKER: Chairman Bromwell, Robinson Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians

- He spoke of history, past and present. Era by Era

- Genocide era which ended in the 1920's. Basically no regard for Indians as human beings.

- Boarding School Era – Indian children taken from their homes and put into schools to learn and be indoctrinated into a white way of life.

- Extermination Era – 1950's where the good intentions of "We are all Americans" forced or pushed many to adopt the American way of life which included taxes, etc. One hand giveth and the other taketh.

- Relocation Era – 1960's. Working to get tribes to assimilate into white culture off the reservation.

- Government Era – 1980's. Tribes worked to come up with their own set of governing laws and rules of sovereignty. Everything had to run through the B.I.A. (Bureau of Indian Affairs). BIA pushed back with mandates that individuals had to be 25% native American to join a tribe; had to be 25% Californian if joining tribe in CA. Cannot belong to two tribes. Have to determine if your kids are one or the other.

- Sovereign Era – mid 2000's. Land is now controlled by the tribe. Not bogged down with bureaucracy. Can only expand that sovereignty within the designated land trust. If buying land must adhere to the county, state and federal laws.

- Robison Rancheria Casino started in 1990.

- Best way to support the tribes is to support legislation when on the ballot.
