Pam introduced Stacy Caico of the Workforce Alliance of the North Bay. The Alliance is a network of career centers covering Lake, Mendocino, Napa and Marin counties. Stacy is the point of contact for Lake and Mendo. The Alliance is government funded and provides various programs to assist job seekers and employers.

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit program provides up to \$9,600 to assist in getting employment for targeted populations such as veterans and ex-felons. The On The Job Training Program provides up to 50% of wages during new employee training programs. These training programs can last from 4 to 26 weeks. The Work Sharing Program is designed to avoid employee lay-offs by allowing employees to work reduced hours rather than losing their jobs.

The Alliance will hold a Rapid-Response Layoff Assistance Webinar on April 21, from 10 to 11 a.m. A virtual jobs fair will be held on April 8, from 12 noon to 4 p.m. All regional community colleges are participating in the jobs fair.
