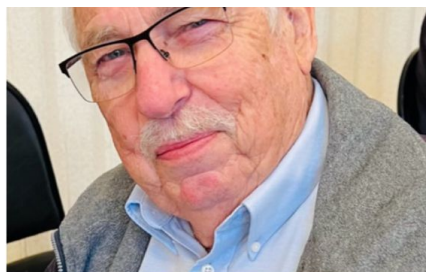

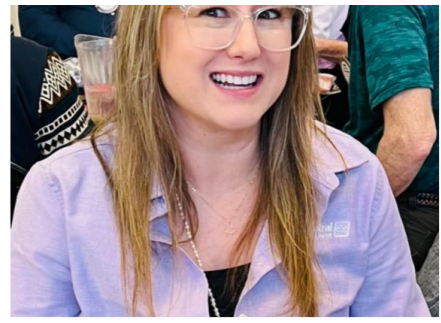
Announcements:

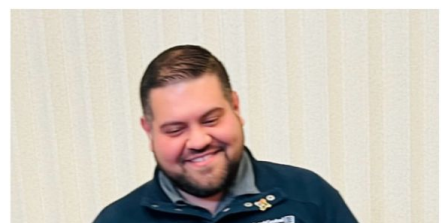
