3. Cal Poly Humboldt sports auction with former S.F. Giants player Jeremy Affeldt on 4.15.23.

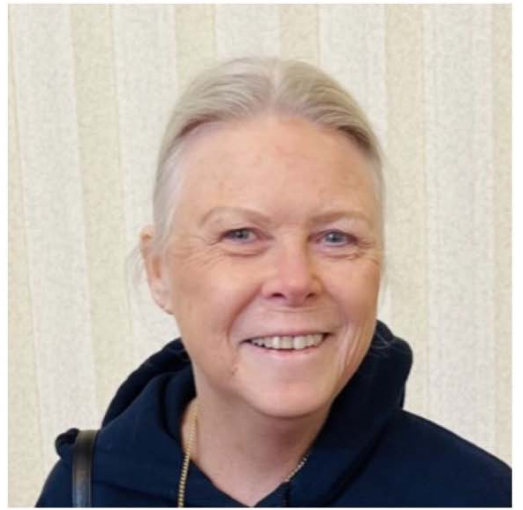
Club Members:

Presenter: Scott introduced Jennifer Johnston from Zoe Barnum, who is a math & culinary teacher at Zoe Barnum. She is also a member of Soroptimist. Jennifer spoke about the purpose of Zoe Barnum, which is in the old Lincoln School building, and allows H.S. kids that fall behind to get back on track with Zoe's credit recovery program. Most of the kids that attend Zoe come from displaced homes, with single or no parent households. Zoe Barnum is more "big picture" learning focused and offers internship programs that allows students to work with local businesses/jobs to get on the job training & experience. She also mentioned that Zoe Barnum has a basketball team that recently won their game against Fortuna. The school also does fields trips whenever possible to get the kids into the community (like Interact Club). Jennifer just took a group of students down to Sacramento to attend a Tobacco Use Prevention Education (TUBE) conference. Students have to meet attendance requirements in order to participate in sports and/or go on field trips.
