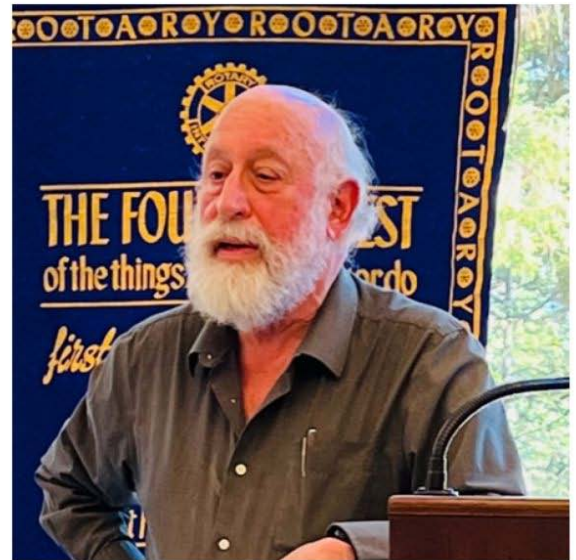
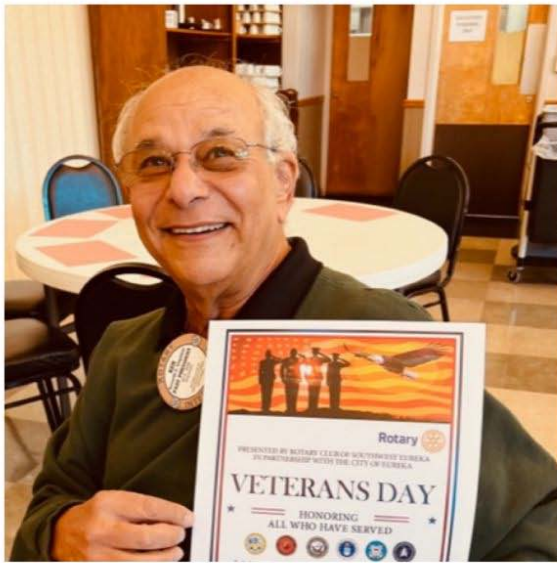
Announcements:
