
John Dalby recently purchased a new truck and also went on road trip vacation to Oregon, Colorado and Utah for 2 weeks.

 $\textbf{Greg Dale} \ \, \textbf{introduced himself as the guest speaker for his presentation on the Good Friday Earthquake that struck Anchorage Alaska on 3/27/1964.}$



Greg and his family were living there at the time when he was two years old. The 9.2 magnitude earthquake lasted for 4 minutes, killed 131 people total, 9 from the earthquake and 122 from the resulting tsunamis, including 11 people killed in Crescent City & 5 people in Oregon.

In addition to the lives lost and destruction, the total estimated costs for damages was roughly \$128 million.
