Steve Carlson (San Carlos Rotary) Updates the Club on the Morocco Water Project

Steve Carlson from Rotary of San Carlos gave a status report March 26 on the Atlas Mountains aqueduct project in Morocco to which Redwood City Rotary has been contributing financial support.

To Redwood City Rotarians the project is more familiarly known as the Moroccan water project. Carlson, now an intellectual properties lawyer, told how the seed for the aqueduct project idea grew from his years with the Peace Corps in the Berber-speaking farming community of Ait Daoud.

He said his Berber father told him be generous and your reputation will go far. And indeed, people in the Atlas Mountain region now know who he is as he makes trips to the village to check on the progress of the aqueduct which will bring irrigation water downstream to Berber farms. With photographs he took RWC Rotarians on a journey to the Atlas Mountains and showed how much more effective a cement aqueduct is compared to old earthen irrigation ditches to bring water down from the mountain. The project requires a Rotary partnering, which has been done with the Marrakech - Majorelle Club with a membership of mostly women. Another partner is Corps Africa-Morocco which is providing a volunteer at the site to help liaise with the Moroccan government's agriculture ministry.

San Carlos is working with other Rotary Clubs in this region besides Redwood City to complete the \$250,000 project. Besides bringing water to farms, the group is planning washing stations outside the aqueduct proper for washing clothes and further down the line will hopefully be a sand filtering system to provide drinking water.
