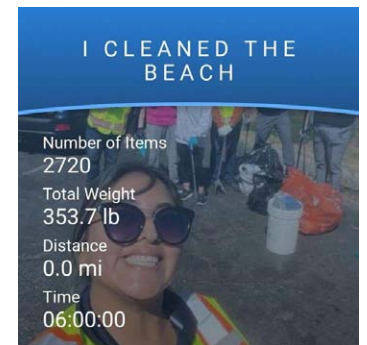


We will be having a lunch meeting this Thursday. Ron will be having some golf games to entertain us.

WE EMPOWER...LOOKING FOR SPONSORS FOR YOUNG WOMEN AND MEN PROGRAM

Antioch Rotary Club is a leader and innovator with our "We Empower" Youth Programs. We have impacted over 10,000 students so far! We have two programs that are fantastic for the development of young adults. With 70 percent of Antioch students socioeconomically disadvantaged these programs become super important to our community. We need to show our students how to succeed and make goals for their futures. For this to happen, we need your sponsorship.

Our first program called "Day of Empowering Girls" was developed 7 years ago. Our club working side by side with Antioch Unified School District administrators and their staff developed and implemented this program for all 8th grade girls.

The program has been modified and improved over the years. The most impactful part of the program – Panelists made up of Local, Successful, Women with a variety of careers (Lawyers, Doctors, Engineers, Police Officers, CEO's, etc.) and with a demographic make up in line with the student body each give a short Bio and how they work to overcome the glass ceiling and then answer questions. A few years ago we added a motivational speaker who is known for her "I Define Me" program which fits in perfectly for what we are trying to do. We also have break out sessions where the 8th grade girls discuss their expectations of high school and are facilitated by High School "Girl Power Girls" letting them know what they can expect. This program has been well received and complimented by School Administration and others. This program will be October 27th and we need volunteers.

Our second program is the "Kings' Conference", focusing on primarily young African American males in our school district who are enrolled in AUSD Manhood elective or are nominated by the school principal at their school. This is our third year of doing a "Kings' Conference". On February 9th we will have approximately 160 students in an all day program with local, successful panelists and powerful facilitated discussion sessions. Topics include: Discovering your Inherent Greatness, Persistence, Mastering the Game, and Know your Rights and Responsibilities. Past panelists include Akili Calhoun, Wade Harper, Najee Harris, Tammany Brooks and Anthony Trucks.
