Dear Antioch Rotarians & Guests,

May this reach you in the best of health and spirit.

This week, Thursday 4/1/2021 at 12pm PST speaker is City of Antioch Chief of Police Tammany Brooks. Brooks born in ♦San Francisco Hunters Point Area♦ knows a lot about troubled life and starts. He dropped out of high school due to many variables but eventually reclaimed his life by getting his GED and eventually obtaining his Master♦s Degree. He is a long time resident of the City of Antioch. The City of Antioch is a full service municipal agency serving a population of more than 114,000 residents. The police department is authorized a sworn staff of 104 officers and 33 non-sworn employees, which includes Dispatchers, Community Services Officers and Administrative Support staff.

The department is comprised of two divisions: Support Services and Field Services. The Field Services Division includes Patrol, Community Engagement, and Traffic Bureaus. The Support Services Division consists of Administration, Dispatch, Investigations, Special Operations, and Records. Antioch is the only city in Contra Costa County with its own animal shelter and services, both of which also fall under the purview of the police department. Our police department is located in downtown Antioch, near the Marina, in a 67,000 square foot facility. It features an indoor firing range, weight training/exercise room, and community meeting room that also serves as the city♦s primary Emergency Operations Center when necessary.

Officers may work in a variety of assignments including Patrol, Traffic, Community Engagement Team, Investigations, SWAT, Hostage Negotiation, Field Training, and K-9. Assignments for our non-sworn staff varies as well, with assignments in Administration, Secured Records, Crime Analysis, Dispatch and Investigations. Community Services Officers can also be assigned to Evidence, Custody, Training, CSI, and the Front Counter. Most of Antioch♦s training is conducted in-house. Officers with special expertise may apply for and become instructors. These officers provide training in the areas of first aid, defensive tactics, firearms, emergency vehicle operation, tactical communications,

## Day Of Golf 2021

The Antioch Rotary Club's Day of Golf, a social spaced activity, has been planned for May 7, 2021 which allows everyone the enjoyment of playing golf with friends and community members in a safe environment while helping the Antioch Rotary Club fundraise for the community. This event raises the funds for our Rotary Club to do great things in 2021/2022 when Ana Cosovic is our President.

Our event has built into our "Day of Golf" all of the social distancing practices utilized by Lone Tree Golf and Event Center - Starting times for each foursome going off in 9-minute intervals starting at 7:00 AM, one person per cart, etc. We can book starting times up to 1:30 PM. We will be serving a lunch after golf for each of the groups utilizing Lone Tree's beautiful Patio Dining area where you can watch competing groups coming up #18 and cheer them on. Each group will have about an hour and a half or so in the dining area to eat, drink and be merry! (While remaining at the table you were seated at and with the group you arrived with per current Covid dining guidelines) Since individual carts will be utilized our rounds are expected to be 3 hours and 30 minutes and you have a choice of formats - Scramble or Cha-Cha for those that would like to play their own ball. Each Rotarian is expected to sell \$125 in raffle tickets. We will not be separating the tickets by 3 different prize packages; instead, we will pool all the raffle tickets in one big pool with 20 prizes. We would like each prize to be a minimum of \$200 in value with a maximum of \$2,000. As far as tickets, we will continue as we did for our "October Day of Golf" - ticketless. As you sell tickets you will be given the next series of numbers for those tickets - e.g. if you buy 10 tickets and 800 tickets have already been sold, you will receive numbers 801 to 810. Winners will be selected via a random number generation. Raffle prizes will be available for pick up on the day of the golf tournament until 5:30 pm after that time ... special arrangements will need to be made. If you win, you are responsible for picking up your prize.

We will need everyone's help with raffle prizes. You can donate a prize or also choose to donate a monetary amount such as \$100 directly to Antioch Rotary Club for the purpose of purchasing gift cards or raffle prizes on your behalf.
