It started with President **Jim Kohl** presenting **Melissa** with a \$20K check on behalf of the club.

Key Facts about the RotaCare Clinic:

RotaCare Bay Areaâ \in TMs website says it well: $\hat{a}\in$ ceRotaCare Bay

Area is a volunteer alliance of medical professionals, organizations and community members dedicated to providing free primary quality health care services to uninsured families and individuals with limited ability to pay for medical care. We are volunteer driven and supported solely through locally

based philanthropy.â€

Our Concord Clinic is all volunteerrun except for one paid staff member who works 30 hours a week. She is the appointment taker and takes care of all logistics.

RotaCare Bay Area, Inc. has 9 clinics in the greater Bay Area. The first one was opened in 1989. Our Concord clinic's planning began in 2007, and opened to patients in 2009. Concord has the distinction of having the first mobile clinic in

the Bay Area, the RotaCare family. We provide in-person care 4 times a month, as well as telemedicine appointments. The clinic is available to anyone without insurance.

Services provided are: Lab follow-ups, medication refills, physical exams, x-



rays, ultrasounds, health education, weight loss advice, diabetes classes, and more. Once a month, a clinic is dedicated to women's health needs.

Financial support is provided by: Kaiser Permanente, Concord - Pleasant Hill Healthcare District, West America Bank, individual donations, and donations from various Rotary Clubs (including today's \$20,000!)

Community Partners include: John Muir Health, CC Pathology, Monument Crisis Center, Lab Corps, Operation Access, Salvation Army, Cambridge Elementary, National Charity League, and Kaiser Permanente

Thank you, Melissa, for catching us up on RotaCare, and for reminding us why it is so important to our community.
