



Speaker

The speaker today was Scott Thurmond, a consultant helping the City of Concord develop a Homeless Strategic Plan.

The Homeless Strategic Plan is also being guided by a Homeless Strategic Plan Advisory Committee appointed by the City Council. The City Council will be getting an update on the beginning steps of this planning process at their meeting on June 27. There have been two community outreach meetings to discuss issues around the unhoused in Concord and there will be several more later this year when the draft Strategic Plan is released for public review.

The purpose of the Strategic Plan is to assess what the current situation is and to identify gaps in services/solutions - what are best practices? The goal is to have a draft Strategic Plan for discussion and City Council adoption by this fall - September/October.


On This Day June 20



- *1791 King Louis XVI and the French royal family are caught during an attempt to flee Paris during the French Revolution, severely undermining their credibility*






