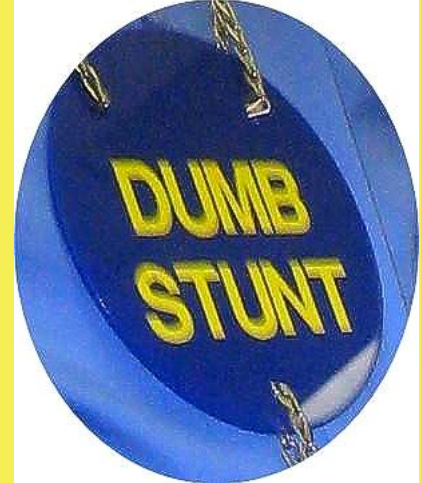




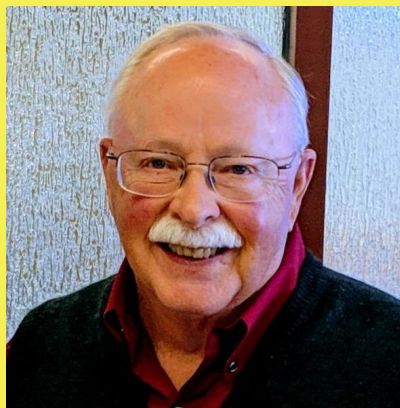
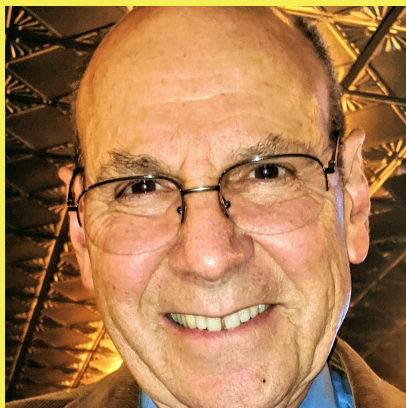
MICHAEL KASIN
