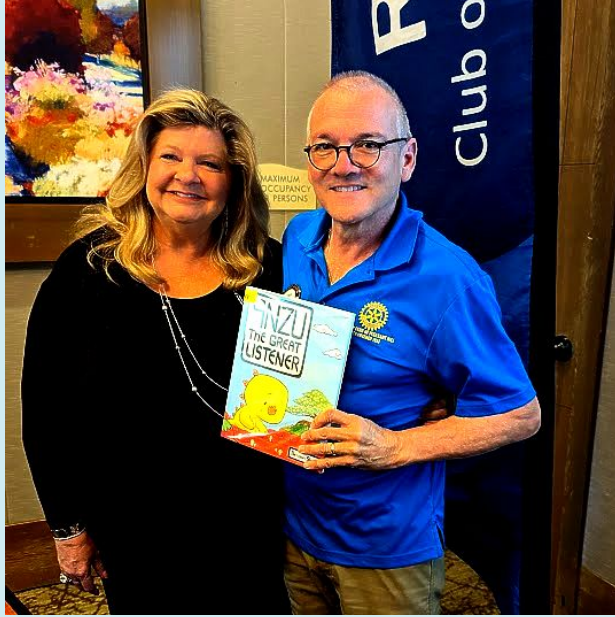
LAST WEEK'S MEETING

Shelley Ham from Rooms of Hope presented the program.

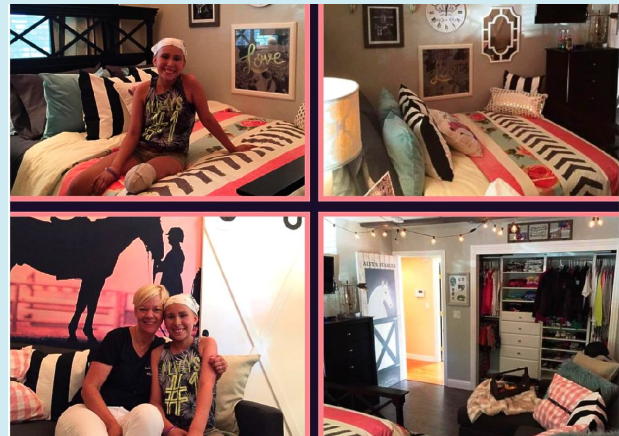
ROOMS OF HOPE is a 501(c) non-profit organization serving 9 counties that make up the San Francisco Bay Area.

In essence, they create rooms that matter for children with a serious illness during a time when life is anything but predictable. Each child is paired up with a project manager and



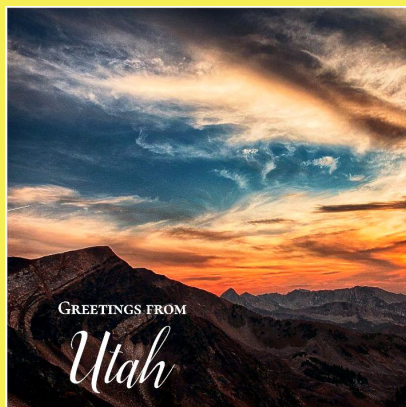
interior designer. They design a space that meets not only their immediate functional, storage, and medical needs, but also allows that child to begin the process of healing and dreaming about tomorrow....

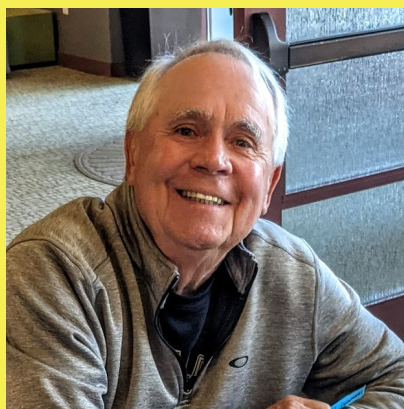

\$50 HD to the club for a trip he took to Hawaii and \$100 to his PHF for his Daughter Hannah to Trae Schuller. wedding next week.

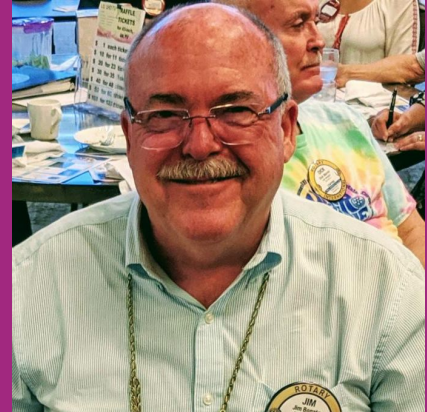
TOM MCHALE
