

Jocelyn Reite gave \$20 HD to the club for successfully dropping off her niece to Cuesta College in San Luis Obispo.





#### What is the status?

... The bid committee made up of representatives from Rotary districts 5130, 5150, 5160, 5170, 5180, 5190, 5220, and 5230 submitted a full proposal for consideration

to Rotary International.
(each club belongs to a District- Our District is5160 with 70 Clubs including ours)

The proposal was reviewed favorably and Rotary International is sending a site inspection team this September to review facilities and preparedness to host Rotarians from around the world. San Francisco is one of 2 cities scheduled for a site visit. The other is Minneapolis Minnesota.

#### When will we know?
