OUR GRANT APPLICATION APPROVED FOR \$11,000 MATCHING DDF

Last week we were notified that the D5160 Grant Committee Approved the entire District Grant Fund request for \$11,000 matching Designated District Funds. Our Club and the other DV8 Clubs will provide

The Comprehensive Rehabilitation Center of Colon (CRICOL), which has been in operation for 16 years in the municipality of Tocoa, state of Colon, Honduras, is a non-profit organization, which has as an objective: To improve and promote changes in the lives of people with disabilities. Eighteen months ago it was offered a facility by the township which CRICOL occupied immediately. While it was more spacious and accommodating, the facility lacked rehabilitation materials and equipment of all kinds. Rotarians from Concord and Pleasant Hill, CA have made visits to the sites and assessed the real needs there.

CRICOL provides services in the following areas: Psychiatry, Early Stimulation, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Language Area and psychology. All services are delivered by eight licensed professionals. Two years ago, the Rotary Club of Pleasant Hill provided 50 LN-4 hands which have been distributed. More will be needed.

The purpose of this grant is to purchase essential rehabilitation equipment, including:

- freezer; hydrocollator; hydrotherapy tank for the upper body.

In giving them the land and the building, the municipality has assured CRICOL that they will pay for all utilities permanently.

Procurement of this equipment will benefit more than 350 patients, from infants to senior citizens, who are diagnosed with diseases such as cerebrovascular events, lumbago, neck pain, delayed psychomotor development, cerebral palsy, sequelae of fractures, sequelae of amputations, neuropathies, congenital diseases, Guillain Barre syndrome, osteoarthritis, arthritis, Parkinson's, and others.

In 2021-22 Our members donated **2,960** hours providing community services. At the rate of at \$25.23 per hour this totals **\$70,139.40** in value donated to community activities in and near Pleasant Hill.

- It was believed to have originated outside the U.S.
- The individual was an unvaccinated adult who suffered paralysis and was hospitalized.
- The chain of infection may have started with someone who received the oral polio vaccine, which uses a live but mild virus strain that can still spread



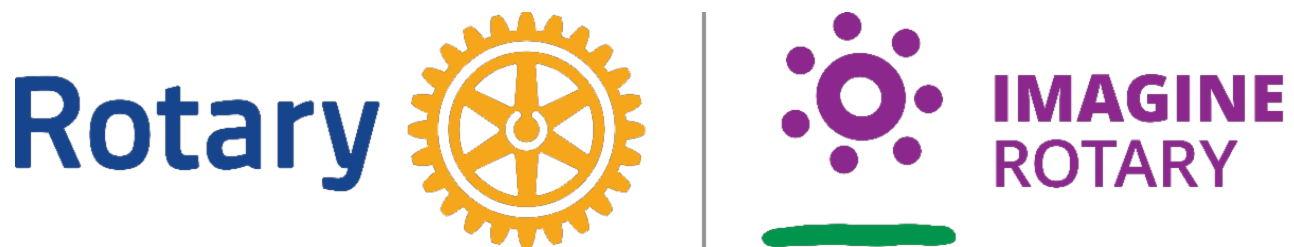
