



# Rotary International President 2022-23

## Rotary International's First Woman President

Jennifer Jones, member of the Rotary Club of Windsor-Roseland, Ontario, Canada, is the first woman to take office as Rotary International President in the service organization's 117-year existence

President Jones 55, was born in Windsor, Ontario, and — save for a few post-college years working in the Turks and Caicos Islands and Manhattan — has lived there her whole life.

Jones started her own television production company when she was in her late 20s. Media Street Productions Inc. is a 25-year-old, award-winning media company in Windsor, Ontario

Jennifer joined the Rotary Club of Windsor-Roseland in in 2000 and i=In 2001-02, served as Club president .

At that point, her district had never had a female governor. She was under 40, and she "wanted to try to take that for a ride," she says. "I knew I wanted to put my full-on energy into Rotary. I loved it."

After her term as governor in 2007-08, she chaired the local chamber of commerce and the University of Windsor board of governors.

In 2009, when Jones was diagnosed with breast cancer at the age of 42, her days turned to chemotherapy and radiation. She got the diagnosis in the fall, and she had been asked to speak at the International Assembly, the training for incoming district governors-elect, in January 2010. Then-RI President-elect Ray Klinginsmith encouraged her to come if she was able. In consultation with her oncologist, she decided to attend. "The Sunday before, I lost all of my hair," she says. "I showed up at the event in a wig.



During her one-year term, Jones will focus on building new relationships and

establishing collaborations with organizations that share Rotary's commitment to driving impact through humanitarian service and to developing leaders around the globe. She has also made Rotary's commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion a key part of her presidential platform. wants members to imagine the possibilities in the change they can make to transform the world.

Jennifer wants our members to imagine the possibilities in the change they can make to transform the world. "Imagine, a world that deserves our best," Jones told incoming district governors on 20 January, "where we get up each day knowing that we can make a difference."

Jones closed her address by saying that although we all have dreams, acting on them is a choice we make. When an organization like Rotary dreams about big things like ending polio and creating peace, she said, it becomes our responsibility to make them happen. "You don't imagine yesterday," Jones said, "you imagine tomorrow."

### **PDG Steve Lack starts his year as District 5160 Vice Governor**

Starting on July 1, our member and Past District Governor (2013-14) Steve, began his second tour of duty as D5160's Vice Governor. His first stint was in 2019-20 for then District Governor Tina Akins.

The Vice Governor only becomes active in the case where the current District Governor is unable to carry out their duties. This has yet to ever occur in our District..


