LAST WEEK

We had a full house for Council member (and PH Rotarian) Sue Noack's report on the State of the City. She used Mayor Tim Flaherty's presentation to highlight the major accomplishments of 2022.

By far the most visible of these accomplishments was the opening of the new Pleasant Hill Library.

Already there have been 218,000 visitors and 200,000 books have been checked out.

The City is in good financial condition with revenues of \$35,483,000 estimated for 2023-24 of which 47% comes from Sales tax and 24% from property taxes.

Expenses for the same period are anticipated to be \$36,615,000 with 70% allocated to staffing.



The Police department represents 36% of the expenses.

Measure K produces \$5 Million per year, that besides funding the library construction also goes to road repavement and maintenance and improvement of storm drains.

The Tourist Improvement District generates \$700,000 per year.
The City is finalizing the 2040
General plan which has a housing target of 1800 new housing units.

The next big discussion and issue will be the possibility of District City Council Elections in the future.




