




LAST WEEK'S MEETING



Wreck of the Barque Illie.

ON Thursday morning Captain Brown, of the ill-fated barque Illie, arrived in Sydney from Brisbane by the A. S. N. Company's steamship Egmont, and from him we have details of the circumstances attending the loss of the vessel, and the saving of the crew. The Illie sailed from Newcastle on the 15th February, with a cargo of 1100 tons coal for Manila, and all went well until March 4, when she struck on a sunken reef on the north-west coast of Guadalcanar, one of the Solomon Group. After bumping for about 20 minutes she floated off into deep water, and then commenced to leak badly. The pumps were got to work, but it was of no avail, and as the ship appeared to be in a sinking condition she was beached. She was afterwards abandoned, as the natives were apparently hostile. Captain Brown, his wife and family, and the crew of the barque, were brought from Ugi to Brisbane in H.M.S. Lark. The Illie was uninsured, but the cargo was covered for £600 in the China Traders' Insurance Company's office.
