

We are so happy to share a quick update from the Bid Committee to bring the 2028 Rotary International Convention to San Francisco

What is the status?

... The bid committee made up of representatives from Rotary districts 5130, 5150, 5160, 5170, 5180, 5190, 5220, and 5230 submitted a full proposal for consideration

to Rotary International.
(each club belongs to a District- Our District is5160 with 70 Clubs including ours)

The proposal was reviewed favorably and Rotary International is sending a site inspection team this September to review facilities and preparedness to host Rotarians from around the world. San Francisco is one of 2 cities scheduled for a site visit. The other is Minneapolis Minnesota.

How can I be a part?

You can participate, like your member Past District Governor Steve Lack, and support the bid for the Rotary International Convention by joining over 200 Bay Area Rotarians attending

Rotary Day at the Giants! It will be a fun evening with Rotarians across the 8 co-host districts.

When will we know?

We should receive feedback on our bid in the first part of 2024.

What are the next steps?

Rotarians across Northern California and Nevada are working hard to prepare for the site visit. We'll put our best foot forward with the site inspection team.


