#### **PROGRAM**

**Carl** introduced our speaker Richard Stein who is the President of Davis Sunset Club. He also introduced Koen Van Rom who is a veterinary doctor from Belgium. Koen through his work at UC Davis has done research on infectious diseases. Koen is a social worker and aids activist. He is also a member of the Davis club and joined us to talk about a water project in Kenya.

Koen founded Sahaya International, a non-profit organization. Sahay means help in Sanskrit. It is a 100% volunteer-based organization with the moto, An act of kindness inspires. Be a drop that creates that ripple. Some of the work of this organization includes the movie, Going Beyond which you can watch for free on their website and the Orphan and School program in Kenya. A recent water project was completed to repair broken borewell. Referred to as the Rumbiye borehole community project, the project included a partnership between Engineers without Borders, Rotary Clubs, the Rumbiye community and Sahaya International. Youth in the community had been walking several kilometers to fetch water from pond used by live stock so not clean because their borewell was broken. Children there were required to bring small amount of water to school each day or sent home because no water was available at the school. The borewell was completed by Engineers without Borders and community extremely grateful. A current project entails a water storage tank with solar panels a shallow well for existing hand-pump and two cattle troughs.
