Brentwood Strong

This week's guest speaker was Seana Fippin (Brentwood Rotarian) who was one of the creators of BrentwoodStrong, a nonprofit that was created during COVID-19 to serve the residents of Brentwood with food delivery and assisting seniors.



BrentwoodStrong is a grassroots effort to help local senior citizens that are most vulnerable during the COVID-19 health crisis.

This help is specifically in the form of boots-on-the-ground volunteers picking up and delivering food and supplies, as ordered and paid for by those needing them. Volunteers are paired up with a senior in need and they work together to assist and pickup necessary items.

Post-pandemic BrentwoodStrong is still serving seniors, including the Adopt-A-Senior holiday program that served 178 seniors this past 2022 holiday season (Oakley Rotary adopted 2 of these seniors). Adopt-A-Senior is a fantastic way to spread the holiday cheer to our community's seniors. There are many who don't have the means, family, or are in good enough health to truly enjoy their holidays.



Adopt-A-Senior 2023 has already begun fundraising for this year's holiday season.
