

On May 18, our presenter was Jessie Plummer of Delta Schools Federal Credit Union.



Jessie discussed the partnership that Delta Schools Federal Credit Union has with local area high schools and middle schools to implement an interactive financial education simulation in managing money. Students are exposed to a "bite of reality"

that introduces them to what it means to create a budget based on an imagined salary, making connections between how their families view money and spending habits, as well as the pitfalls of financial debt when life circumstances occur. For many students, the experience was an eye opener with an emerging sense of financial literacy.


