out programs that achieve beneficial changes in our world, like improved living conditions, increased food production, better education, and brighter hopes for peace.

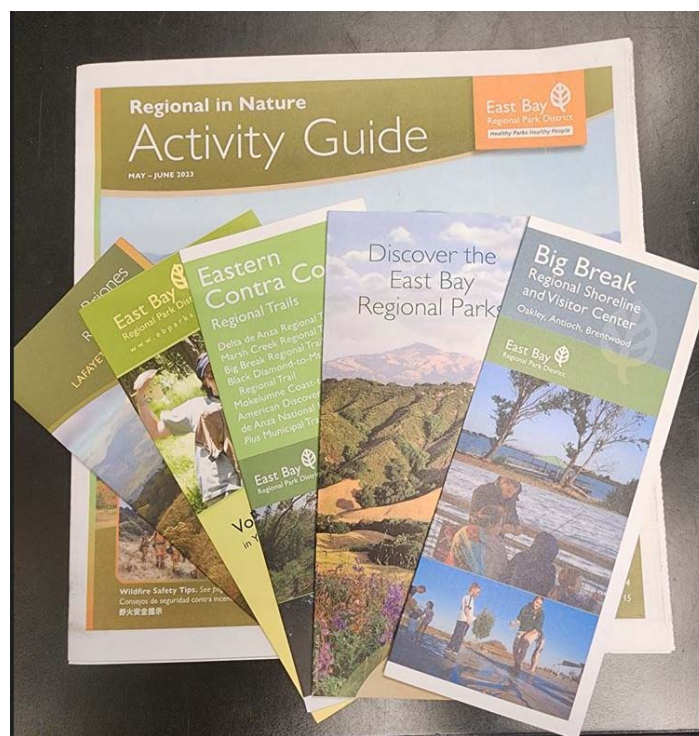
Wyatt Moore: East Bay Regional Parks

Wyatt gave us an update on East Bay Regional Parks as well as the history of, and upcoming events at Big Break Regional Shoreline located right here in Oakley.

The Big Break Visitor Center, which was completed in 2012, includes hands-on and informational displays about the Delta. The center is staffed by Naturalists and Student Aides who are happy to share information about the park and activities in the area, including wetland walks and adjoining trails. In addition, Big Break Regional Shoreline offers picnic and meadow areas, a small shaded amphitheater, boat and kayak launch facilities, and a fishing pier.
