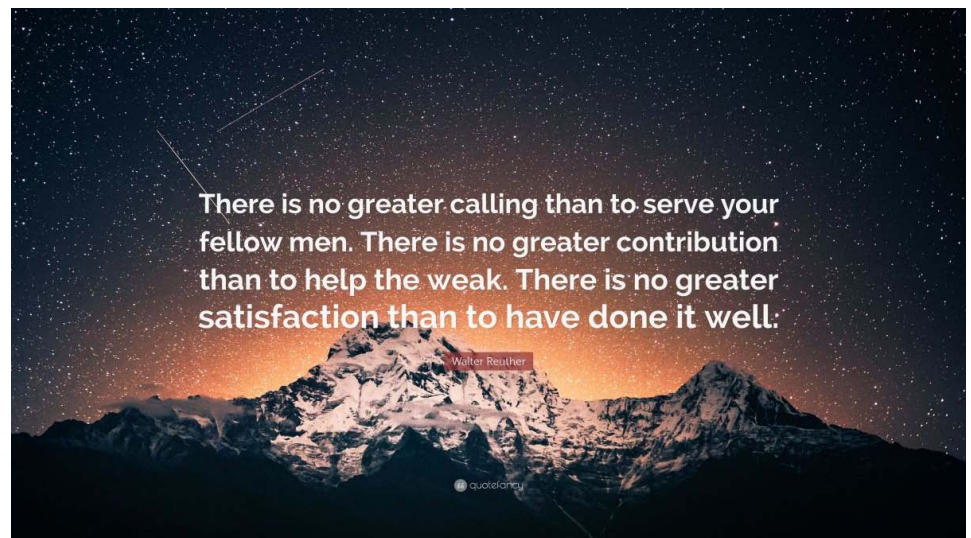

He is a husband, father of four children, 3 dogs and 1 horse, and has 2 grandchildren. His hobbies include fishing, trips to the gun range and traveling to other states with his wife. He has had a long career in law enforcement, and that might make some want to protect their privacy, but he wants you to know who he is as a professional and as a person.
