

For more than 100 years, Scouting has provided programs and activities to develop a sense of community service, encourage nature conservation, build self-confidence, and reinforce ethical behaviors in young people.

She briefly discussed some of the negative situations of adult misbehaviors, bankruptcy, and decreased membership in past years. These challenges led to reforms and new procedures to ensure youth safety. In addition, Scouting has evolved to become more inclusive of young people in that boys and girls now participate and work together. Finally, Natalie highlighted that the Scouting Laws align nicely with Rotary's motto of Service Above Self.
