

### **Guest Speaker 10/10/2024**

### Barrett "Barry" Morris, Lt. Colonel (Retired) U.S. Air Force



This week's Program Speaker was retired Lt. Colonel Barrett "Barry" Morris of the U.S. Air Force. He leads and teaches the Air Force Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (AFJROTC) at Heritage High School in Brentwood. In 2023, he received the Teacher of the Year award. With 23 years of military and 4 years of teaching

experience, he educates and mentors over 119 cadets.

The AFJORTC curriculum is 40% Aerospace Science, 40% Leadership Education, and 20% Health and Wellness Studies. The program explores the historic and scientific aspects of aerospace technology and teaches high school students self-reliance, self-discipline, and other leadership skills. Cadets are expected to participate in community service to instill a sense of civic pride. Cadets can apply to attend a summer aviation program to earn their Private Pilot's License at an accredited university and are eligible for Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) scholarships for higher education.

Students from Liberty HS and Freedom HS can stay at their school and attend the AFJROTIC program at Heritage HS or completely transfer over to Heritage HS.
