Club Assembly (Oct. 24, 2024)

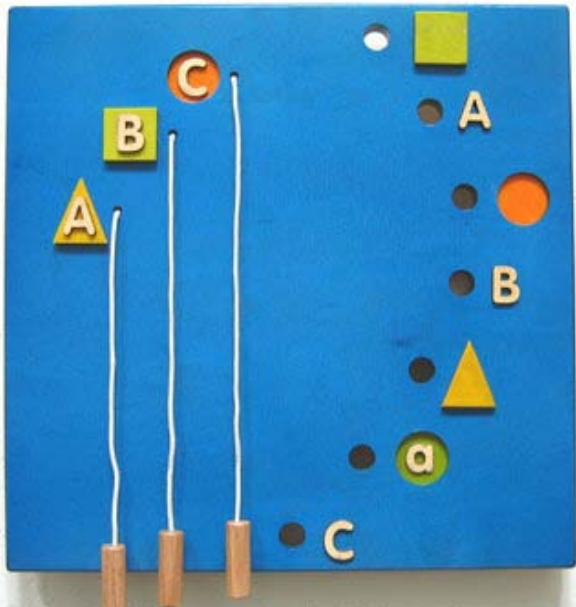
Club Assembly
