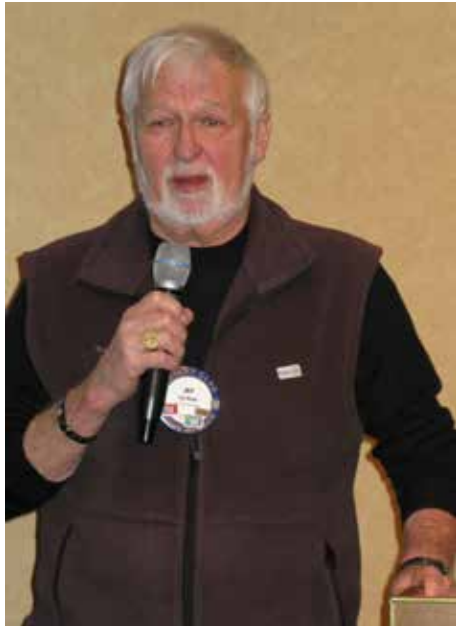

The speaker of the day, Kathy Wilson, discussed her organization, “New Day for Children” and its mission to rescue children who are victims of sex slavery.

She noted that world-wide there are about 34 million juvenile sex slaves, a large increase from the number just several years earlier, 27 million. She said that the average age for young girls to be enslaved is 12-13 years old; whereas, for boys it is a younger age, 8-11 years old.

She pointed out that pervasive social media – as she held up a cell phone – enables the slavers to target and trap vulnerable children in the USA, where juvenile sex slaves may number in the hundreds of thousands.

Her organization has a bucolic “ranch” where rescued victims may recuperate. In the past ten years, they have rescued nearly one hundred children and have had a high rate of success. Her organization will hold a Freedom Fundraiser 5k walk/run at the Lafayette Reservoir. One may register at www.newdayforchildren.com.

The Navakiran Orphanage - Kathmandu



Livermore Rotary's Nepalese Children's Fund has been helping the poor children of Kathmandu for 26 years. The fund began spontaneously from the club after John Shirley and Paul Thompson returned from a trek in the Himalayas where they delivered medical equipment to a medical clinic operated by Luke Sunde. Luke was then living in Kathmandu with his wife Marion and both were very much involved in working with the very poor. Much of their work involved children.

Upon their return Shirley and Thompson gave a talk at the club which included the poor children of Kathmandu. The members of the club at the end of the talk offered to donate money to help Luke in his endeavors. The fund has grown organically since then with the club donating tens of thousands of dollars.

The need is even greater now since the devastating earthquake in 2015.

The Navakiran orphanage suffered significant damage. Much of the damage has been repaired and the boys dormitory upgraded with windows and a new door. We are looking for funds now to complete waste management and solar water heating and also a new structure to accommodate the children in inclement weather. When completed, the home is planning to house, clothe, feed and educate 50 children. Currently there are 45 being cared for.

Please keep the date of April 27, at 2pm open. A fundraiser afternoon of music, singing and wine pairing will be held at June and Dave Bedford's home. Nick Liang, Chef at Uncle Yu's and a talented opera singer, will sing and also pair some of his food with wine. Michael Ferrucci and JR Romero with their talented friends will provide more great entertainment.
