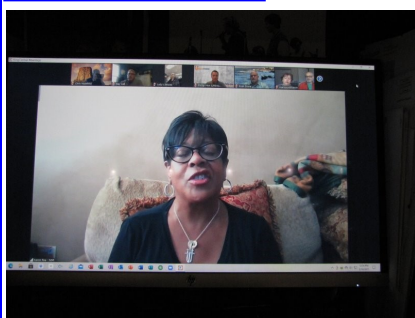

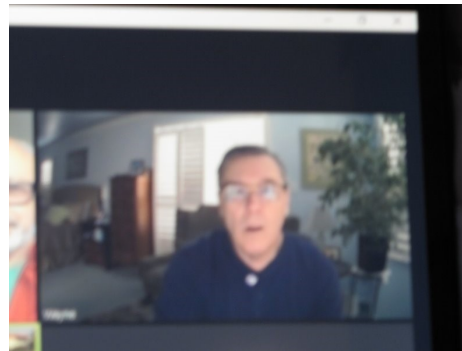

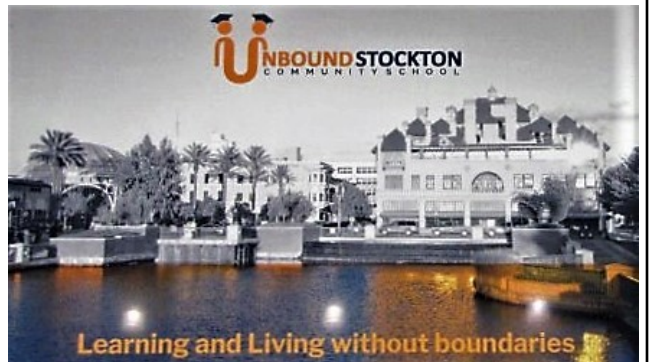

Evan Stone announced he will need help with our zoom engineering next year. He would also appreciate any speaker suggestions

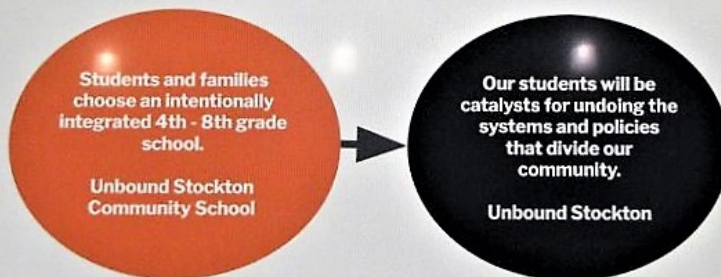
