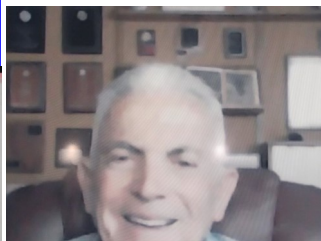

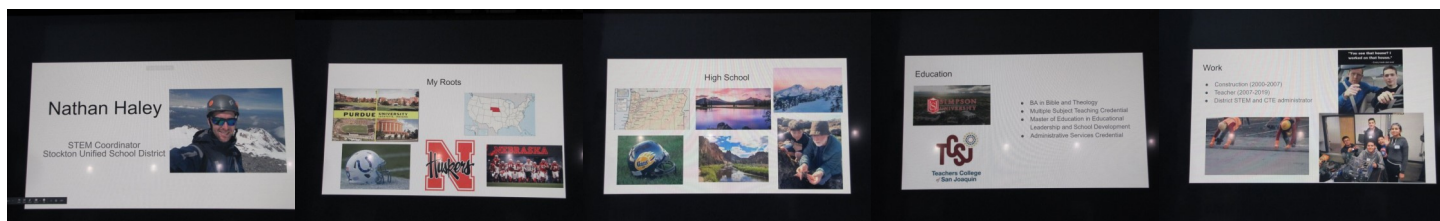


President Karen also wanted to thank Tod Anton for his tireless work on our Sunshine Committee, that pays attention to the well being of our members.

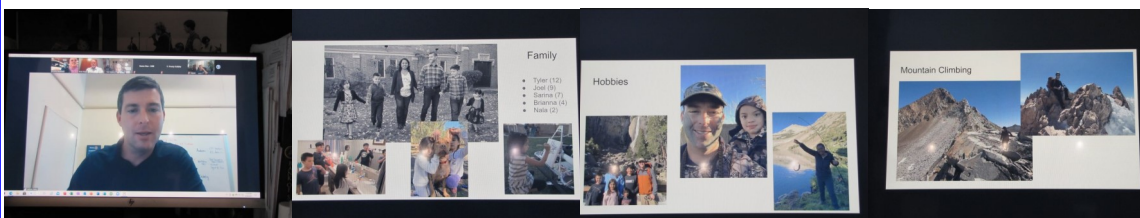
Sunshine Tod, himself!
