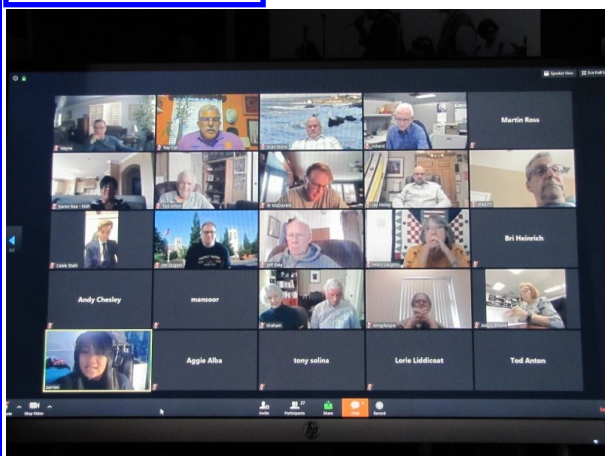

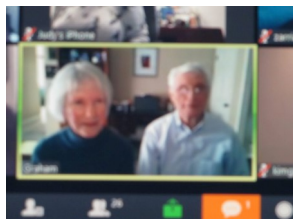

Now because of modern technology I will give you exactly what Ray said!

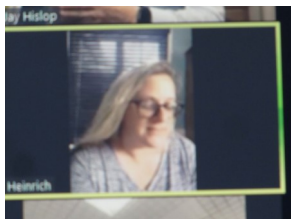

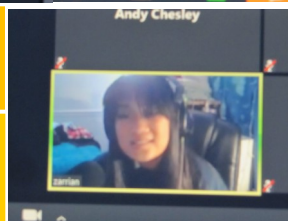
