Franklin D. Roosevelt First Inaugural Address

Saturday, March 4, 1933

I am certain that my fellow Americans expect that on my induction into the Presidency I will address them with a candor and a decision which the present situation of our Nation impels. This is preeminently the time to speak the truth, the whole truth, frankly and boldly. Nor need we shrink from honestly facing conditions in our country today. This great Nation will endure as it has endured, will revive and will prosper. So, first of all, let me assert my firm

belief that the only thing we have to fear is fear itself—nameless, unreasoning, unjustified terror which paralyzes needed efforts to convert retreat into advance. In every dark hour of our national life a leadership of frankness and vigor has met with that understanding and support of the people themselves which is essential to victory. I am convinced that you will again give that support to leadership in these critical days.

Karen then squashed the rumor that acknowledging birthdays the first meeting of every month will be abandoned. She said that January and February will be observed in February, Get those party hats ready!

In 1994 immigrated to the United States. Was introduced to Rotary on the Russian-American district Conference in the 90th in Denver, Colorado.


Became member of the Lakewood-Rocky River Rotary Club (Cleveland area), Ohio in 1997)
