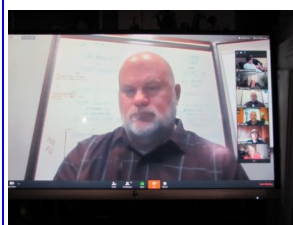

Virtual Meeting 01/26/21

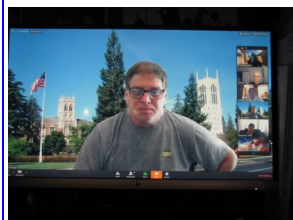

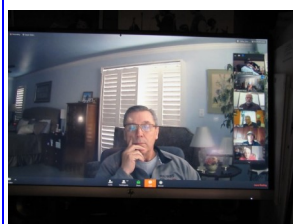

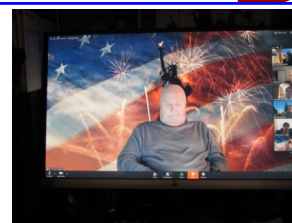
Scholar-shiping Away!

Wayne announced that the scholarships should be decided soon. More to come.

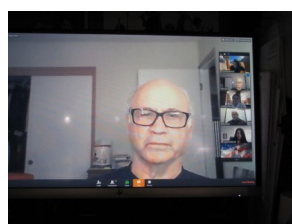
The Area 2 speech contest will be February 2. Judges will be Aggie, Andy and Jay.

Easter Baskets will be assembled this year. Only 350 will be made, we will possibly put them together at a Tuesday meeting.

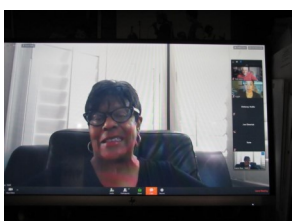
Karen asked if we'd like to return to Brookside, and we said yes! So possibly in 2 weeks we will be live. Fingers crossed!



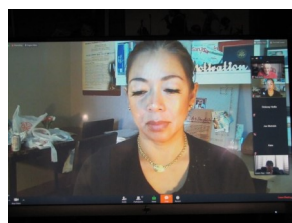

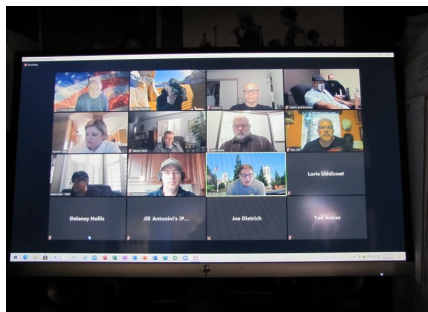
We need a volunteer for Secretary! Please line up and tell Karen!

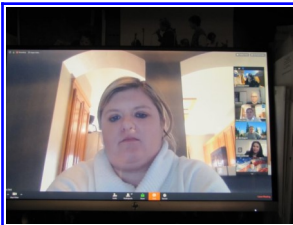

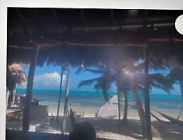

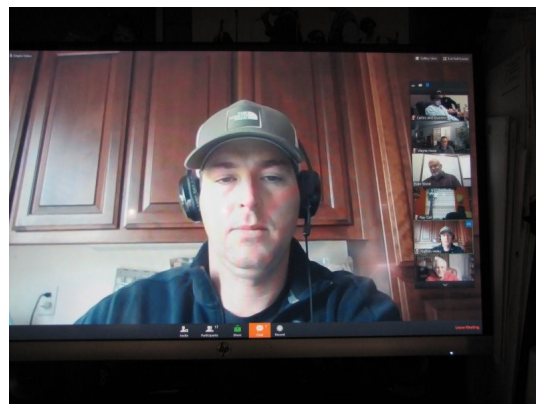
