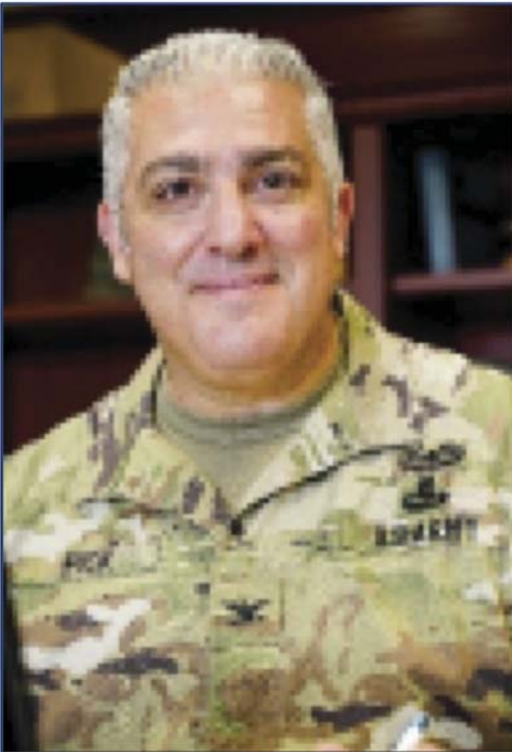
COG Bio Presentations

Scout Executive/CEO Boy Scouts Of America

Eric Tarbox is currently the Scout Executive & CEO of the Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council, Boy Scouts of America, serving more than 9,222 registered youth in Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Benito, and Santa Clara Counties with 4000 volunteer leaders, 25 full time staff, and a \$6million annual budget. Eric started with the BSA in 1995 in Louisville, Kentucky. Utilizing his background as a USMA Preparatory School graduate, VMI alumnus, and Army Combat Engineer Officer (light/airborne), success came quickly and the BSA moved his family to assignments in Las Vegas, Santa Clara, Dallas, Maine, and to his

current assignment in Monterey. His proudest career success is partnering with the Pentagon's IRT program to provide \$50million of pro-bono construction for the \$327million Bechtel Family National Scout Reserve, a 10,000 acre build which Eric managed. His proudest life success is building a family with Annie Tarbox who currently works for the Monterey Peninsula College Foundation. Annie and Eric have 2 children: Luke Tarbox, Eagle Scout, currently attends VMI on a USMC 4 year scholarship. Hannah Tarbox served 5 years as an F35B Avionics Marine, mostly overseas in Iwakuni, Japan, and is now home looking for a local career. An individual qualifier for the 1993 US Olympic Pistol Team tryouts, Eric enjoys competitive shooting, flying, classic motorcycling, archeology, and history. Of all the places the Army and the BSA asked the Tarbox Family to serve, they love Monterey the most and wish to stay.

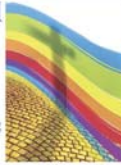

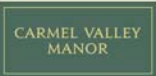
