Tyller Williamson State Of The City

Tyller Williamson brings a wealth of experience in public service and community leadership to his role as Mayor of Monterey.

Tyller was elected to the Monterey City Council in 2018. Upon completion of his term, he was elected Mayor in 2022. Tyller is also a public servant in his career, recently transitioning to a role in the Department of Veterans Affairs specializing in Human Resources, with a focus on Labor and Employee Relations, bringing his expertise to serve our nation's veterans.

Prior to this, Tyller made significant contributions to the Naval Postgraduate School, where he worked from 2010 to 2023, and was honored with the Civilian Service Achievement Medal for his exemplary service.

Tyller's leadership skills were evident early in his career as the Deputy Regional Field Director for President Obama's 2012 re-election campaign. In this role, he effectively managed a team of over 500 staff and volunteers, showcasing his expertise in community organizing.

Applying lessons from early in his career, Tyller quickly became active in the Central Coast community, advocating for various community organizations and initiatives. He emphasizes unity and collaboration among residents from all walks of life to address Monterey's diverse needs and priorities.

Since 2022, Tyller has served on the board of the Community Foundation for Monterey County (CFMC), chairing the Community Impact Investment Committee. Under his guidance, CFMC has played a pivotal role in inspiring philanthropy and bolstering communities across Monterey County, with significant grants totaling \$41 million in 2023.

Tyller collaborates closely with regional partners to uplift the quality of life on the California Central Coast of California. He aims to continue fostering collaboration to address our community's critical challenges such as affordable housing, transportation infrastructure, and sustainable water management, ensuring that Monterey remains a vibrant and inclusive community for all.

Tyller holds a bachelor's degree in Human Communication, Pre-Law, from California State University Monterey Bay, and a Master of Business Administration from the Naval Postgraduate School. When he is not working or attending a public meeting, Tyller enjoys spending time with his partner Ivan and their dog Sasha.

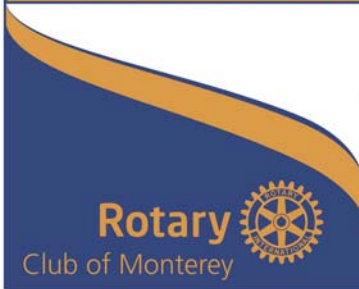
