such as Tioga-Sequoia Brewing. He saw the success of the micro brew pub in Sanger and thinks that Reedley is the ideal location for his brand of home crafted brews.

Adrain's vision for Nightmonster Brewing is more of a boutique wine-tasting-type establishment, not a rowdy bar with drunk patrons and ill repute. He is leasing the former Mosquito Abatement District building on I Street, which he intends to turn into a family-friendly, dog-friendly indoor/outdoor gathering spot, replete with board games, cornhole, and patio seating. Food will be provided by food trucks on the patio. His brews will include some of his standard favorites year-round, but will tickle the senses with seasonal brews that use local fruits, nuts, and flavors. Much to Mike Franks delight - and perhaps Nicole's as well - there may even be a red ale somewhere in the mix.

Nightmonster has submitted a Conditional Use Permit with the City for the establishment. The City's Planning Commission will get first bite at accepting or rejecting the idea of the City's first brew pub sometime in March. From there, it is likely that the City Council will be asked to weigh in. But the real question is how long the State's Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) will take to issue an alcohol license for that site. If all gets approved smoothly, the Brewing Company hopes to open its doors this summer.
