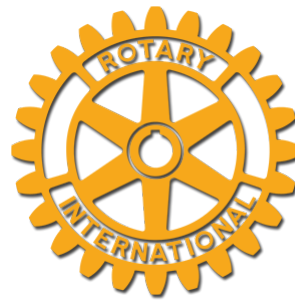

The Blossom Trail

Fred McNairy presented a nice history of our area's Blossom trail. The sponsorship started with Fresno County and bounced around, including through Fred McNairy. It ultimately ended up with Pacific Gas & Electric sponsoring the event in conjunction with the various cities along the route.

Fred had two samples of the official artwork prepared for the Blossom Trail Posters each year. Two of the posters were also on display.



Each spring, Fresno County explodes into fragrant beauty as the fruit trees begin to bloom. Formed in 1989, the Fresno County Blossom Trail highlights the splendor and abundance of the Central Valley's plum, almond, citrus, peach, nectarine, apricot, and apple orchards. Many communities are represented on the trail including Sanger, Reedley, Orange Cove, Selma, Clovis, Kingsburg, and Fowler. Each town has its own charm and history. Simonian Farms is the official start of the 62 mile long Blossom Trail.

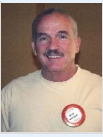

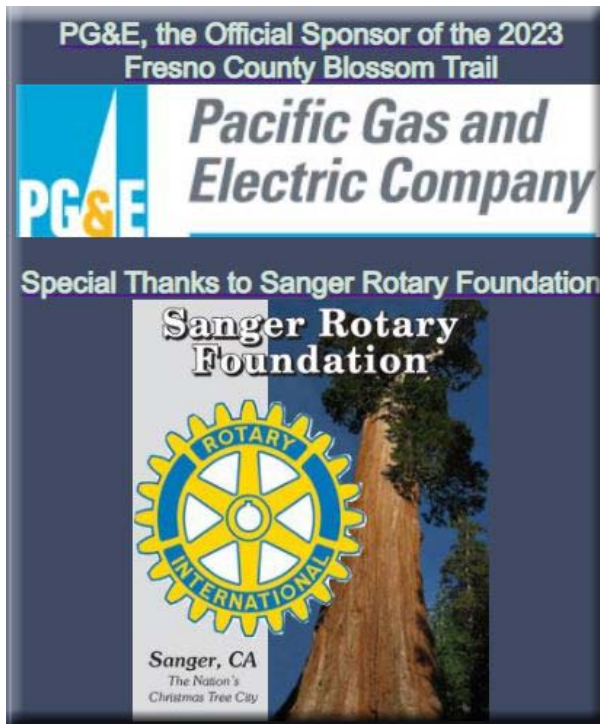
