Identiy Theft

Identity theft occurs every two seconds. Identity theft is when information is accessed. Identity fraud is when that information is used for personal gain. Your information can be used to make transactions, open new accounts, obtain prescriptions, receive medical treatment, buy things, ... it's difficult to come back from identity theft. Someone can look over your shoulder as you enter a password or when you offer your credit card for payment. The thieves take a picture with their cellphone of information, credit card numbers, passwords, etc. They can steal your mail, dumpster dive information from your garbage, take your purse/wallet. There are email phishing scams, telephone scams, and scams directed at the elderly. If it sounds too good to be true, it usually is. Monitor your accounts for small charges you don't recognize ... those might be "testing the waters." Don't use public WiFi, secure important documents, be aware of your surroundings, shred any mail that has personal information, and don't click on unknown links in emails. Artificial Intelligence can now mimic voices. Don't buy cars online. Once you send money, you lose control of it. If you don't know the
