TLC is an intensive 3-day program designed to develop leadership skills in outstanding 8th graders from our district. Important dates and facts to remember: Intents are now due by **September 20th**, a bit earlier this year to finalize numbers. The cost for each student has increased to \$375. Student applications are due by **November 1st**, and club decisions must be finalized in DacDB by **November 15th**.
