Change in Dues Structure. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Rotary International Dues and District Dues have increased over the past 5 years. In order for us to keep up with the increase, on August 22nd the Board of Directors of the RCAFV have agreed to increase our Club dues to cover the expenses while maintaining the lowest possible investment for you. Monthly Dues will be increased by \$10.00 which would be \$45.00 rather than \$35.00. In addition to that, our club fundraisers are down significantly due to COVID amongst other things. We are asking that everyone make a \$12.50 monthly donation to our Rotary Club of Apple Valley Foundation. ### October 24th is World Polio Day

World Polio Day October 24th  
Please Give generously this week

#### Greetings Polio Warriors:

WILD POLIO VIRUS, TYPE 1 (WPV1) - Hallelujah!!! There were NO new cases of WPV1 reported this last week.

**TWENTY-SEVEN** - The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Pakistan (September 15th).

**FORTY-THREE** - The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Afghanistan (August 29th).

**SIXTY-THREE** - The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Mozambique (August 10th).

**THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN - (10 MONTHS +)** - The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Malawi (November 19th, 2021). **TWENTY-NINE** - The total number of cases of WPV1

that has occurred in 2022 year-to-date (2 in Afghanistan, 7 in Mozambique and 20 in Pakistan).  
**SIX** - The total number of cases of WPV1 that occurred in 2021 (1 in Pakistan, 1 in Malawi and 4 in Afghanistan).  
**ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY** - The total number of cases of WPV1 that occurred in 2020.

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS polio, also known as poliomyelitis, can be a disabling and potentially life-threatening disorder,  
and

WHEREAS Rotary International (also known as Rotary) is a global network that unites leaders and problem-  
solvers in taking action to create lasting change in communities across the globe, and

WHEREAS the eradication of polio is one of Rotary's longest standing and most significant efforts, and

WHEREAS Rotary launched PolioPlus and helped establish the Global Polio Eradication Initiative to  
immunize the children of the world against polio, and

WHEREAS Rotary International has designated October 24 as World Polio Day, and Rotary members in  
British Columbia are committed to sustaining this progress in eradicating polio by helping to vaccinate every  
child world-wide;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 24, 2022, shall be  
known as

**"Polio Awareness Day"**

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our  
Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS, The Honourable Janet Austin, Lieutenant Governor of Our Province of British Columbia, in Our  
City of Victoria, in Our Province, this thirteenth day of October, two thousand twenty-two and in the first  
year of Our Reign.
