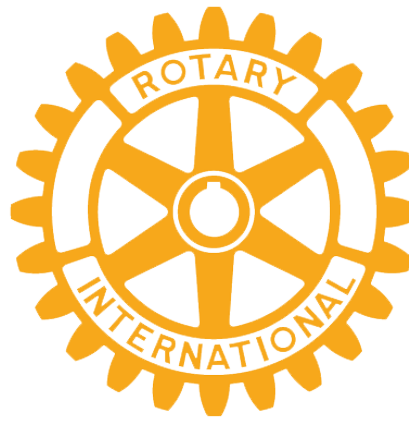

Dr. Gary Dorf gave a talk titled " Keeping Your Brain Healthy: Hearing Loss, Cognitive Decline, and Dementia." He and Christopher Medina are colleagues. Dr. Dorf is a representative for Oticon Hearing Device Technology.



Dr. Dorf reviewed common signs of hearing difficulty:

- People seem to be mumbling.
- It's harder to follow a conversation in meetings, restaurants or noisy places.
- You try to limit social activities because it is difficult to hear or communicate.

Ultimately, it is a good idea to have your hearing checked annually and accept hearing technology.
