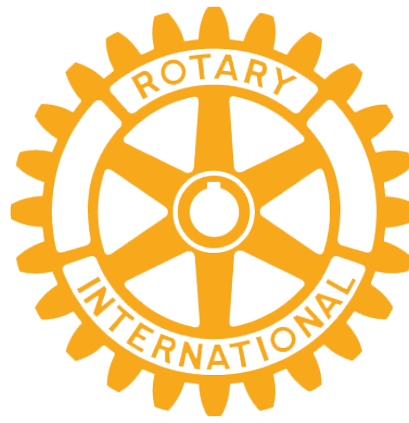

President Manny Presents State of the Club



Approximately one-third of the members responded to Manny's survey.

- Most members are fairly satisfied with how the Club is moving.
- The meetings are utilized well.
- We can do better getting new members involved.
- The Club reflects the demographics of the community.
- The members feel generally positive about our service projects. International service projects could be improved and increased.
- New members should be fully involved in the Club prior to receiving the "blue badge."

In October the Club will have a Fireside Chat at Gabriel Garza's home. The purpose of the Fireside Chat is to tell new members about all aspects of Rotary.

Manny also informed the Club that we will need to raise funds to complete the projects planned for this year. The charitable projects are budgeted as follows:

- 7 Youth Service Projects at a cost of \$8,250
- 12 Community Service Projects at a cost of \$5,750
- 4 Vocational Service Projects at a cost of \$4,700
- 2 International Projects at the cost of \$2,500
- Totaling \$21,200

Many has plans to pay for the projects:

- Approximately \$5,000 has been donated to Club to date.
- \$5,000 is expected from a Finance of America Grant.
- The Beer Garden will not be a viable fund raise for the Club.
- The Club will ask members to commit to finding \$250 in sponsors. The Montebello Reporter will provide

- Jay Nomura will donate \$1500 for the Masae Nomura Music Contest.
- The Hensel Endowment Fund will pay the prize money for the Hensel Ethics Essay Contest.
- The Club will have a fund raiser at Sanchez Adobe on Saint Patrick's Day. Manny expects to raise \$3,000-\$4,000.
- The shortfall is about \$3,000.

The Club is expecting up to 7 new members to be inducted at the Governor's visit.

Manny is asking each member to donate \$100 per year to the Paul Harris Society.

The public image of the Club is lacking. Manny is working on signage around the community.
